



## INTRODUCTION

Manga Taniwha ki rangaunu trust rose from a need to activate whänau health and wellbeing through practises of kaitiaki in the Awanui River Catchment. We have since planted up to 40,000 locally sourced trees along publicly accessible areas within the Kaitaia township, sourced support from kaitaia local businesses, local and regional council towards community planting events, supported wananga that engage whänau and hapù to share matauranga of our taiao and tupuna of the far north, provided resources to whänau and hapù that give effect to kaitiakitanga practises and support the wellbeing of rangatahi in the far north through mentoring.







We have plans to build a new local native nursery here in Kaitaia.

Our plan is to eco-source all our plants from local seeds in the future.

Our Wananga space will deliver workshops on environmental issues and impacts from knowledgeable experts.

Our vision is that by 2032, the life force of wai sustains its own ecosystems and improves the health and well-being of Tangata Whenua within the Northen area.
